




## **INTRODUCTION**

EXPLANATORY NOTES

THE FOLLOWING DEFINITIONS HAVE BEEN USED IN THIS REPORT

TOURISM:

Tourism denotes the temporary, short movements of people to destinations outside the places where they normally live and work, for other than business or vocational reasons and their activities during the stay at these destinations.

Tourism represents various types of short-term travel and visits and is variously defined for particular purposes, by reference to the purpose of the journey, its duration and other criteria.

VISITORS:

A visitor is a non-resident person (national or alien) usually resident abroad, who enters Dominica and intends to stay for not more than one year for non-immigrant purposes such as touring, recreation, leisure, business, study or family reasons. Visitors have been divided into the following categories:

- (i) TOURIST: Any person who stays at least one night but not more than 365 nights in land accommodations.
- (ii) EXCURSIONIST: Any person who does not stay for any one night in any land accommodations.

Hence, an excursionist may either be a flight passenger who departs from Dominica on the same day he arrives, or a boat passenger who sleeps on board the vessel in a port of Dominica.

RESIDENT:

Any person (national or alien) who has been residing or has been given permission to reside for more than one year and who has not yet been abroad for more than one year.

TOURISTS ARE SUB-DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Holiday visitors whose purpose of visit is expressly stated as vacation. These visitors are classified either as staying in hotels, guesthouses or cottages, or as staying in private homes (i.e. with friends or relatives).
2. Business visitors who come for private as well as governmental business purposes. Included also are research workers from international institutions such the U.N., the I.M.F. and the CARICOM Secretariat.
3. Students who are permitted to enter to pursue a course of study at a school or university.
4. Other visitors, that is, visitors not covered by the previous three categories.

O.E.C.S.: Antigua, Dominica, Grenada, Montserrat,

Trinidad & Tobago

FRENCH WEST INDIES: Martinique, Guadeloupe, The Saints,  
St. Martin and St. Bartholomew

SCANDINAVIA: Norway, Sweden, Denmark with  
dependencies, Finland and Iceland

TRAVEL REVIEW  
1994

Visitor arrivals recorded an 11.3 percent increase over the year, bringing total visitors to 65,331 in 1994 (Table 7). The Caribbean region accounted for 56.6 percent of those visitors. The other major market, Europe, followed with 23.7 percent and the U.S.A. contributed 14.9 percent (Table 1). The French West Indies and the United Kingdom continue to be the main contributors to these leading markets. July has been the most popular month for visitors over the last five years (Table 7A). Correspondingly the third quarters of the same period recorded the highest number of visitors (Table 4A and previous reports).

Visitor arrivals have been increasing steadily from two (of the three) main markets, Europe and the U.S.A. over the last six years (Table 4). Except for a drop in 1992, the Caribbean would have otherwise followed this trend (Table 4). Sea visitors reached a record high in 1994 (Table 5). However air visitors continue to fluctuate, since attaining its high in 1991 (Table 6).

The percentage of visitors using air travel has been declining since 1990 (Table 2 and previous reports), while those travelling by sea has been continually increasing. This is because of the increasing number of French West Indies visitors (the main sub-group market) who preferably choose sea travel.

Although LIAT (an Antigua-based airline) regained its share of the market in 1992, a decline was noted over the year (Table 3). Air Guadeloupe has also been experiencing a drop since 1992. WINAIR (a St. Maarten-base air carrier) accounted for 3.9 percent of visitors. Madeikera (a sea vessel) has increased its share over the year, moving from 22 percent to 26 percent of all sea visitors. However Caribbean Express continues to be the leading carrier.

The Canefield airport, the main port of entry, continues to record steady decreases for the last five years (Table 2), as Woodbridge Bay the main port for sea visitors has been capturing more visitors since 1990. Again the reason may be the increase number of visitors from the French West Indies (the leading sub-group market) choosing sea travel.

Tourist arrivals continue to increase, recording an 8.8 percent change over the year. In general, 30 percent of tourists registered for a 1-3 day stay (Table 10). All countries in the European market recorded increases over the year (Table 8A). Those from the United States mainly chose more than a 22 day stay with New York, Florida and California remaining the main contributors to that market. Tourists from the French West Indies (the major sub-group market) registered for a 1-3 day stay and so influencing the Caribbean market length of stay.

Over the year, the percentage of hotel and guest house visitors have declined while those in apartments/cottages and other paid accommodations have been continually increasing over the last six years (Table 13 and previous reports). Excursionists increased by 30 percent over the year. The French West Indies accounted for 54.6 percent of excursionists (Tables 19 and 20) increasing by 73.5 percent over the year. In fact, 1994 experienced a record high for the French West Indies and United Kingdom markets.

Cruiseship calls and passengers increased by 22 percent and 46 percent respectively over the year. The first quarter remains the most popular calling period.

Total passenger arrivals have been climbing since 1992 (Table 23). However a 5.2 percent decline was noted in air arrivals over the year. Sea arrivals registered a 39.5 percent increase, a record high in 1994.

CHART 1: VISITOR ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE 1991 - 1994




CHART 2: VISITOR ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE 1991 - 1994




CHART 3: PERCENTAGE OF TOURIST ARRIVALS BY PLACE OF STAY 1990 - 1994







CHART 4: NUMBER OF EXCURSIONISTS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE 1992 - 1994





**CHART 5: CRUISESHIP CALLS (EXCLUDING WINDJAMMERS)**
