



INTRODUCTION

The **1998 Travel Report** covers information on travel in and out of Dominica for the last ten years. This report presents data on visitor port of entry, airlines and sea vessels activities, countries of residence, length and place of stay, purpose of visit and cruise arrivals. The aim of this **annual** report is to assist interested persons, establishments, firms or institutions in readily recognizing visitor/tourist trends in Dominica. This report will help in easily identifying chief, potential and untapped markets and also provide information on the flow, activity and market share of main aircraft and sea vessels.

Periodically, relevant information will be added and slight changes will be made in the contents of these reports. Therefore, all suggestions from users which can assist us in being more efficient will be welcomed.

The Central Statistical Office is grateful for the co-operation it has received from the Immigration Department, the Canefield and Melville Hall Airports, the Division of Tourism and the various cruise and airline agencies.



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EXPLANATORY NOTES

THE FOLLOWING DEFINITIONS HAVE BEEN USED IN THIS REPORT

TOURISM: Tourism denotes the temporary, short movements of people to destinations outside the places where they normally live and work, for other than business or vocational reasons and their activities during the stay at these destinations.

Tourism represents various types of short-term travel and visits and is variously defined for particular purposes, by reference to the purpose of the journey, its duration and other criteria.

VISITORS: A visitor is a non-resident person (national or alien) usually resident abroad, who enters Dominica and intends to stay for not more than one year for non-immigrant purposes such as touring, recreation, leisure, business, study or family reasons. Visitors have been divided into the following categories:

- (i) TOURIST: Any person who stays at least one night but not more than 365 nights in land accommodations.
- (ii) EXCURSIONIST: Any person who does not stay for any one night in any land accommodations.

Hence, an excursionist may either be a flight passenger who departs from Dominica on the same day he arrives, or a boat passenger who sleeps on board the vessel in a port of Dominica.

RESIDENT: Any person (national or alien) who has been residing or has been given permission to reside for more than one year and who has not yet been abroad for more than one year.

TOURISTS ARE SUB-DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Holiday visitors whose purpose of visit is expressly stated as vacation. These visitors are classified either as staying in hotels, guesthouses or cottages, or as staying in private homes (i.e. with friends or relatives).
2. Business visitors who come for private as well as governmental business purposes. Included also are research workers from international institutions such the U.N., the I.M.F. and the CARICOM Secretariat.
3. Students who are permitted to enter to pursue a course of study at a school or university.
4. Other visitors, that is, visitors not covered by the previous three categories.

THE COUNTRY GROUPINGS USED IN THE TABLES ARE DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:

O.E.C.S.: Antigua, Dominica, Grenada, Montserrat, St. Kitts/Nevis, St. Lucia and St. Vincent

OTHER CARICOM: Barbados, Belize, Guyana, Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago

FRENCH WEST INDIES: Martinique, Guadeloupe, The Saints, St. Martin and St. Bartholomew

SCANDINAVIA: Norway, Sweden, Denmark with dependencies, Finland and Iceland

1998 TRAVEL REVIEW

Visitor arrivals recorded a 2.6 percent decline over the year. The continued drop in excursionists influenced the slow growth and decline in total visitor arrivals. Visitors arrivals has not surpassed the 1995 record of 68,838.

The bulk of arrivals, 55.9 percent continues to originate from the Caribbean Market with the French West-Indies contributing, 50.7 percent of visitors (Table 1). The United States, the second leading market, capturing this position from Europe since 1996, accounted for 21.3 percent of visitors this year. Europe registered 18.2 percent with France contributing 48.1 percent of the market.

Over the year however only the Caribbean Market recorded an increase; still a slight 0.2 percent. All other major markets registered decreases with the largest, 10.8 percent reflected in the European Market (Table 1A).

Air arrivals accounted for 69.7 percent of total visitors. Melville Hall, taking over as the main airport from last year recorded 82.6 percent of air visitors. LIAT, continues to dominate the airline market, transporting 50.6 percent of visitors by air. The American Eagle, the second leading carrier recording a slight percentage decrease in 1997, has regained its 27.0 percent market share this year. Air Guadeloupe has been recording steady growth and after a four-year decline, the airline transported 7.8 percent of air visitors this year.

Sea visitors registered 20,267 the lowest since 1993. The Roseau sea port remains the main port entry accounting for approximately 96.0 percent of sea visitors. Over the last two years the Portsmouth sea port, to the north, registered about 3.0 percent of sea arrivals. Express Des Iles continues to be the main vessel transporting 96.0 percent of sea visitors.

Tourist arrivals increased slightly by a 0.1 percent, over the year. The Caribbean market increased by 2.3 percent, while the European and United States market recorded decreases of 4.1 and 2.0 percent respectively.

The 4-7 day has been the most popular length of stay for the last three years. (Table 11). Holiday tourists continue to account for about 81.0 to 83.0 percent of arrivals whilst business tourists have remained at a stable 12.0 percent since 1995 (Table 12 A).

The percentage of tourists choosing hotels as accommodation has been declining steadily since 1994; moving from 27.0 percent in 1994 to 18.5 in 1998. Conversely guesthouses and apartments have been growing steadily for the same period moving from 19.3 percent in 1994 to 21.0 in 1997. For this year, private homes recorded 56.6 percent of tourists, the highest percentage registered over the last eight years (Table 13 B). This affected

numbers for all paid accommodation, which consequently recorded the lowest percentages in hotels, 18.5, guesthouses, 9.6 and apartment cottages, 4.1 (Table 13 A) The highest percentage of non-nationals was also recorded this year, accounting for 87.4 percent of all tourists.

Excursionists continues to decrease recording the sharpest annual decline this year.

Total passenger arrivals decreased by 1.1 percent, attributed to the 4.1 percent decrease in air arrivals. However, Sea arrivals increased by 7.1 percent. Cruise calls increased by 9.8 percent while passengers rose by 6.1 percent over the year. The first quarter remains the most popular month for cruise arrivals, registering 40.3 percent of calls.

VISITOR ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE: 1998



1995 - 1998



VISITOR ARRIVALS: 1988 - 1998



1993 - 1998



AND PRIVATE HOMES : 1993 - 1998





NUMBER OF EXCURSIONISTS: 1988 - 1998



1991 - 1998



