

INTRODUCTION



EXPLANATORY NOTES

THE FOLLOWING DEFINITIONS HAVE BEEN USED IN THIS REPORT

TOURISM:

Tourism denotes the temporary, short movements of people to destinations outside the places where they normally live and work, for other than business or vocational reasons and their activities during the stay at these destinations.

Tourism represents various types of short-term travel and visits and is variously defined for particular purposes, by reference to the purpose of the journey, its duration and other criteria.

VISITORS:

A visitor is a non-resident person (national or alien) usually resident abroad, who enters Dominica and intends to stay for not more than one year for non-immigrant purposes such as touring, recreation, leisure, business, study or family reasons. Visitors have been divided into the following categories:

- (i) TOURIST: Any person who stays at least one night but not more than 365 nights in land accommodations.
- (ii) EXCURSIONIST: Any person who does not stay for any one night in any land accommodations.

Hence, an excursionist may either be a flight passenger who departs from Dominica on the same day he arrives, or a boat passenger who sleeps on board the vessel in a port of Dominica.

RESIDENT:

Any person (national or alien) who has been residing or has been given permission to reside for more than one year and who has not yet been abroad for more than one year.

TOURISTS ARE SUB-DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Holiday visitors whose purpose of visit is expressly stated as vacation. These visitors are classified either as staying in hotels, guesthouses or cottages, or as staying in private homes (i.e. with friends or relatives).
2. Business visitors who come for private as well as governmental business purposes. Included also are research workers from international institutions such the U.N., the I.M.F. and the CARICOM Secretariat.
3. Students who are permitted to enter to pursue a course of study at a school or university.
4. Other visitors, that is, visitors not covered by the previous three categories.

THE COUNTRY GROUPINGS USED IN THE TABLES ARE DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:

O.E.C.S.: Antigua, Dominica, Grenada, Montserrat, St. Kitts/Nevis, St. Lucia and St. Vincent

OTHER CARICOM: Barbados, Belize, Guyana, Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago

FRENCH WEST INDIES: Martinique, Guadeloupe, The Saints, St. Martin and St. Bartholomew

SCANDINAVIA: Norway, Sweden, Denmark with dependencies, Finland and Iceland

1999 TRAVEL REVIEW

Total visitor arrivals rose 15.6% over the last year, mainly as a result of significantly higher tourist arrivals. Consequently, this represents a record high number of visitor arrivals (Tables 1A & 8D).

The Caribbean market accounted for 59.6% of all visitors compared to 55.9% last year. The United States maintained its position as the second leading market, registering 20.3% of all visitor arrivals, followed by Europe, 15.8% (Table 1).

Sixty-nine percent of all visitors were air arrivals. Melville Hall, regaining its position as the main airport since 1997, accounted for 56.7% of all visitor arrivals and 82.0% of air arrivals (Table 2). Although reflecting a steadily decreasing market share over the last two years, Liat continues to be the most popular airline transporting 48.8% of air visitors. American Eagle, the second leading airline, recording a steady rise over the last two years accounted for 32.0% of air visitors. Air Guadeloupe, reflecting steady growth since 1997, registered a 57.4% rise over the last year and accounted for 11.0 percent of air visitors (Table 3).

Sea visitors recorded 23,899 arrivals, the highest since 1995. The Roseau seaport accounted for 98.4% of sea visitors. A 57.7% decrease was observed in the Portsmouth seaport over the last year. Express Des Isles was again the market leader, transporting 93.8% of sea visitors. Brudey Freres reflected a 195.8% rise over the last year.

Over the year, the months of July and October registered record high visitor arrivals of 9,828 and 9,283 respectively. For the first time since the start of the World Creole Music Festival in 1997, October recorded a higher number of visitor arrivals than the Carnival month, February/March (Table 7).

Tourist arrivals numbered 73,506 reflecting a 12.2% increase over the year, and a record high (Table 8B). This rise was partly attributed to a regional and international conference during the summer. All major markets registered increases, the highest, 16.5% was recorded in the Caribbean market. Europe registered a 2.5% rise. A 51.4% increase was noted in the Other Caribbean category mainly as a result of exponential increases in the Haitian and Dominican Republic markets. The French islands of Martinique and Guadeloupe collectively accounted for 47.3% of tourists arrivals from the Caribbean and increases of 16.5% and 5.6% respectively. The British Virgin Islands have reflected steady growth over the last two years.

The state of New York, which accounted for 19.7% of all United States tourists, recorded a 17.2% rise over the last period. Florida represented 10.8% of tourists and a 21.0% increase. The third most popular state, California accounted for 6.8% of tourists and registered a 46.5% rise over the last period (Table 8A).

An exponential increase was observed for Ontario, Canada while a 91.2% decline was recorded in British Columbia.

The United Kingdom reflected an 18.9% rise and also accounted for 55.3% of all European tourists. Percentage decreases of 19.9% and 18.0% were registered for Germany and France respectively. However, a notable 93.8% increase was registered for Sweden.

Significant increases have been observed in the Taiwanese market over the last two years, whereas the Chinese market reflected decreases over the same period.

The 4-7 day period remains the most popular length of stay for tourists (Table 11). Thirty-nine percent of all tourists stayed in paid accommodations compared to 38.5% last year. The most preferred type of paid accommodation were hotels representing 47.7% followed by guest houses 28.1% (Tables 13A &3B). Private homes accounted for 55.8% of all tourists although a record high 89.5% of all tourists were non-nationals (Table 16A).

A 167.3% increase was recorded in excursionists for the current period following steady decreases since 1995. This increase was mainly as a result of a sharp rise in excursionists from the French West Indies (Table 20).

Total passenger arrivals and departures rose 11.1% and 7.1% respectively over the last year (Table 23). Sea arrivals registered a 14.8% increase and air arrivals a 9.5% rise.

A 17.4% decline was registered in cruise arrivals over the last year. This decline was mainly the result of a temporary cessation of calls by one of the main cruise vessels (Table 24). The highest number of cruise arrivals were recorded in March and the most popular cruise line was Carnival Cruises (Tables 24 A&B).

VISITOR ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE: 1999



1995 - 1999



VISITOR ARRIVALS: 1990 - 1999



1995 - 1999



1995 - 1999



1999



NUMBER OF EXCURSIONISTS: 1990 - 1999



