

## INTRODUCTION


The **2001 Travel Report** covers information on travel in and out of Dominica for the last ten years. This report presents data on visitor port of entry, airline and sea vessel activities, country of residence, length and place of stay, purpose of visit and cruise arrivals. The aim of this **annual** report is to assist interested persons, establishments, firms or institutions in readily recognizing visitor/tourist trends in Dominica. This report will help identify chief, potential and untapped markets and also provide information on the flow, activity and market share of main aircraft and sea vessels.

Periodically, relevant information will be added and slight changes will be made in the contents of these reports. Therefore, all suggestions from users that can assist us in improving future issues will be welcomed.

The Central Statistical Office is grateful for the co-operation it has received from the Immigration Department, the Canefield and Melville Hall Airports, the Division of Tourism and the various cruise and airline agencies.



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## **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

### **THE FOLLOWING DEFINITIONS HAVE BEEN USED IN THIS REPORT**

#### **TOURISM:**

Tourism denotes the temporary, short movements of people to destinations outside the places where they normally live and work, for other than business or vocational reasons and their activities during the stay at these destinations.

Tourism represents various types of short-term travel and visits and is variously defined for particular purposes, by reference to the purpose of the journey, its duration and other criteria.

#### **VISITORS:**

A visitor is a non-resident person (national or alien) usually resident abroad, who enters Dominica and intends to stay for not more than one year for non-immigrant purposes such as touring, recreation, leisure, business, study or family reasons. Visitors have been divided into the following categories:

- (i) TOURIST: Any person who stays at least one night but not more than 365 nights in land accommodations.
- (ii) EXCURSIONIST: Any person who does not stay for any one night in any land accommodations.

Hence, an excursionist may either be a flight passenger who departs from Dominica on the same day he arrives, or a boat passenger who sleeps on board the vessel in a port of Dominica.

#### **RESIDENT:**

Any person (national or alien) who has been residing or has been given permission to reside for more than one year and who has not yet been abroad for more than one year.

**TOURISTS ARE SUB-DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Holiday visitors whose purpose of visit is expressly stated as vacation. These visitors are classified either as staying in hotels, guesthouses or cottages, or as staying in private homes (i.e. with friends or relatives).
2. Business visitors who come for private as well as governmental business purposes. Included also are research workers from international institutions such the U.N., the I.M.F. and the CARICOM Secretariat.
3. Students who are permitted to enter to pursue a course of study at a school or university.
4. Other visitors, that is, visitors not covered by the previous three categories.

**THE COUNTRY GROUPINGS USED IN THE TABLES ARE DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:**

**O.E.C.S.:** Antigua, Dominica, Grenada, Montserrat, St. Kitts/Nevis, St. Lucia and St. Vincent

**OTHER CARICOM:** Barbados, Belize, Guyana, Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago

**FRENCH WEST INDIES:** Martinique, Guadeloupe, The Saints, St. Martin and St. Bartholomew

**SCANDINAVIA:** Norway, Sweden, Denmark with dependencies, Finland and Iceland

## 2001 TRAVEL REVIEW

Total visitor arrivals for 2001 recorded 68,372 registering a 5.4 percent decline over last year's 72,254 visitors. The major markets recorded percentage decreases in the French West Indies, 11.7; United States, 4.1; and Europe, 3.7 (Table 1A). For the same period, the French West Indies accounted for 29.1 percent of visitors, the United States, 21.0% and Europe, 15.8% (Table 1).

Melville Hall Airport accounted for 72.2 percent of air arrivals. Visitors travelling through Canefield Airport increased sharply by 80.4 percent over last year. Caribbean Star, an airline which started operation in the year 2000, increased its market share from 1.7 to 16.7 percent in 2001. LIAT, the leading airline, recorded a drop in air travellers from 47.2 to 43.5 percent in the current year. The Helen Air airline ceased operations in 2001. The number of visitors traveling on Express Des Iles vessels accounted for 97.5 percent of sea visitors from 96.1 percent in the last year (Table 3). July recorded the highest monthly number of air and sea visitors (Tables 5 & 6).

Tourist arrivals declined by 4.6 percent over the previous year. Percentage decreases were recorded for Canada, 14.1; the Caribbean, 5.2; United States, 3.9; and Europe, 2.9. The Canadian province, Ontario recorded a significant 35.6 percent drop in tourist arrivals. In the Caribbean region, decreases in tourist arrivals were registered for Montserrat, 38.9%; Martinique, 16.4%; and Guadeloupe, 7.5%. The American states, Massachusetts and Connecticut registered decreases of 62.8 and 23.3 percent respectively over the year 2000. Germany and France declined by 13.8 and 7.6 percent respectively contributing to the drop in the European market (Tables 8A & B).

The average length of stay was 7.8 days as compared to 9.2 days in last year. The longest stay, 14.2 days was recorded for tourists from United Kingdom while tourists from the French West Indies stayed for the shortest period, 5.3 days. Most tourists, 27.6 percent registered for the 4-7 days stay. The 1-3 days stay recorded 25.8 percent of tourist arrivals (Tables 9 & 9A). The 22+ days category registered a significant increase, 28.0 percent over the last year (Table 10).

A significant percent, 44.4 of tourist arrivals were recorded from the age group, 25-44 years (Table 11).

Holiday tourists accounted for 82.0 percent of all tourists and came primarily from the French West Indies and United States (Tables 12 & 12A). Tourist in private accommodation increased to 58.7 percent from 54.7 percent in the last year. Of the 38.5 percent tourists in paid accommodations, 53.2 percent stayed at hotels (Tables 13A & B). Sixty-six percent of the tourists in paid accommodation were on holiday while 21.3 percent came on business (Table 14).

About 11.0 percent of tourists were nationals while non-nationals accounted for 88.6 percent. Tourist nationals from the French West Indies accounted for 44.0 percent of all tourist nationals while the United States recorded 23.4 percent, the highest non-nationals. The French West Indies non-nationals followed closely with 23.0 percent.

Excursionists arrivals numbered 1,979, decreasing by 25.5 percent over the year 2000. Significant percentages decreases were registered for United Kingdom, 81.1; Other Caricom, 66.7; O.E.C.S., 62.1; and Holland, 50.0. Excursionists from the French West Indies accounted for 84.5 percent of the total arrivals (Table 19). Cruise passengers and calls decreased by 13.4 and 19.5 percent respectively.

VISITOR ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE: 2001




#### VISITOR ARRIVALS: 1992 - 2001



1997 - 2001



1997 - 2001



2001



NUMBER OF EXCURSIONISTS: 1992 - 2001






