


INTRODUCTION

The **2002 Travel Report** covers information on travel in and out of Dominica for the last ten years. This report presents data on visitor port of entry, airline and sea vessel activities, country of residence, length and place of stay, purpose of visit and cruise arrivals. The aim of this **annual** report is to assist interested persons, establishments, firms or institutions in readily recognizing visitor/tourist trends in Dominica. This report will help identify chief, potential and untapped markets and also provide information on the flow, activity and market share of main aircraft and sea vessels.

Periodically, relevant information will be added and slight changes will be made in the contents of these reports. Therefore, all suggestions from users that can assist us in improving future issues will be welcomed.

The Central Statistical Office is grateful for the co-operation it has received from the Immigration Department, the Canefield and Melville Hall Airports, the Division of Tourism and the various cruise and airline agencies.

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

THE FOLLOWING DEFINITIONS HAVE BEEN USED IN THIS REPORT

TOURISM:

Tourism denotes the temporary, short movements of people to destinations outside the places where they normally live and work, for other than business or vocational reasons and their activities during the stay at these destinations.

Tourism represents various types of short-term travel and visits and is variously defined for particular purposes, by reference to the purpose of the journey, its duration and other criteria.

VISITORS:

A visitor is a non-resident person (national or alien) usually resident abroad, who enters Dominica and intends to stay for not more than one year for non-immigrant purposes such as touring, recreation, leisure, business, study or family reasons. Visitors have been divided into the following categories:

- (i) TOURIST: Any person who stays at least one night but not more than 365 nights in land accommodations.
- (ii) EXCURSIONIST: Any person who does not stay for any one night in any land accommodations.

Hence, an excursionist may either be a flight passenger who departs from Dominica on the same day he arrives, or a boat passenger who sleeps on board the vessel in a port of Dominica.

RESIDENT:

Any person (national or alien) who has been residing or has been given permission to reside for more than one year and who has not yet been abroad for more than one year.

TOURISTS ARE SUB-DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Holiday visitors whose purpose of visit is expressly stated as vacation. These visitors are classified either as staying in hotels, guesthouses or cottages, or as staying in private homes (i.e. with friends or relatives).
2. Business visitors who come for private as well as governmental business purposes. Included also are research workers from international institutions such the U.N., the I.M.F. and the CARICOM Secretariat.
3. Students who are permitted to enter to pursue a course of study at a school or university.
4. Other visitors, that is, visitors not covered by the previous three categories.

THE COUNTRY GROUPINGS USED IN THE TABLES ARE DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:

O.E.C.S.: Antigua, Dominica, Grenada, Montserrat, St. Kitts/Nevis, St. Lucia and St. Vincent

OTHER CARICOM: Barbados, Belize, Guyana, Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago

FRENCH WEST INDIES: Martinique, Guadeloupe, The Saints, St. Martin and St. Bartholomew

SCANDINAVIA: Norway, Sweden, Denmark with dependencies, Finland and Iceland

2002 TRAVEL REVIEW

Visitor arrivals recorded a 3.6 percent rise in 2002. Percentage increases were registered in the major markets of United States, 7.2 and the Caribbean, 5.2. Visitors from the O.E.C.S. recorded an increase of 19.8 percent. However, Europe, the third leading market declined by 6.5 percent. This market decline resulted from sharp decreases recorded for Scandinavia, 33.6%; France, 12.8 % and Holland, 12.5 % (Table 1A).

Melville Hall Airport, the main port of entry, recorded 57.3 percent of all visitors, up from 49.9 percent in the last year (Table 2). Liat remains the principal air carrier accounting for 41.7 percent of the air visitors although it continues to register a steadily declining market share since 1998. American Eagle, the second leading air carrier, recorded 26.2 percent of the air visitors reflecting a decrease over last year. Caribbean Star continues to register steady growth since its inception in 2000. The airline transported 24.1 percent of the air visitors compared to 16.7 percent in 2001. Express Des Iles, the main sea vessel transported 87.4 percent of the sea visitors, down from 97.5 percent in the last year (Table 3). The month of August registered the highest number of air and sea visitors (Tables 5 & 6). A total of 8, 178 visitors arrived during the month of August (Table 7).

Tourist arrivals rose by 4.2 percent with percentage increases recorded for Canada, 9.0; United States, 6.7 and Caribbean, 6.4 (Table 8B). For Canada, the province of Ontario recorded 25.8 percent of the tourist visiting Dominica. The states of New York and Florida accounted for 20.1 and 11.2 percent respectively of the tourist arriving from the United States. Caribbean tourists from Guadeloupe, Martinique and Antigua/Barbuda recorded the highest percentages of 27.6, 14.5 and 13.2 percent respectively. United Kingdom and France registered 55.8 and 23.2 percent respectively of European arrivals (Table 8A).

The 4-7 day stay remains the most popular intended length of stay. Within that category, percentage increases were recorded for United States, 23.1; O.E.C.S., 29.4 and Canada, 31.6 over the year. The 8-14 intended length of stay category registered increases of 51.5%, 15.7% and 12.0% for the O.E.C.S., Canada and United States respectively. The numbers of tourists in the intended length of stay categories, 4-7 days and 8-14 days increased by 21.0 and 13.6 percent respectively over 2001. (Tables 9 & 9A) About fifty-two percent of the tourists were males while forty-eight percent were females (Table 11).

Tourists on holiday accounted for 81.4 percent while 12.5 percent came on business (Table 12A). A 5.9 percent drop was recorded in the number of tourists staying in hotels. However, apartment and cottages registered a significant 31.2 percent increase. The percentage of tourists staying in private homes increased from 58.7 to 61.3 percent in 2002. About eighty-nine percent of the tourists were non-nationals while nationals accounted for eleven percent.

Excursionist arrivals dropped to 1,674 from 1,979, recording a 15.4 percent decline with the French West Indies, the main market, decreasing by 25.9 percent (Table 19A).

Resident arrivals and departures registered a negative net outflow of 1,362, increasing over the year 2001 (Table 22A). Cruise ship calls and passengers recorded decreases of 19.0 and 34.1 percent respectively (Table 24). This decline can be attributed to the prior global events which affected the travel industry over the year.

VISITOR ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE: 2002



1998 - 2002



VISITOR ARRIVALS: 1993 - 2002



1998 - 2002**



1998 - 2002**



2002**



NUMBER OF EXCURSIONISTS: 1993 - 2002



PASSENGER ARRIVALS BY CRUISESHIP 1993 - 2002



CRUISESHIP CALLS : 1993 - 2002



