

## **INTRODUCTION**

The **2005 Travel Report** covers information on travel in and out of Dominica for the last ten years. This report presents data on visitor port of entry, airline and sea vessel activities, country of residence, length and place of stay, purpose of visit and cruise arrivals. The aim of this **annual** report is to assist interested persons, establishments, firms or institutions in readily recognizing visitor/tourist trends in Dominica. This report will help identify chief, potential and untapped markets and also provide information on the flow, activity and market share of main aircraft and sea vessels.

Periodically, relevant information will be added and slight changes will be made in the contents of these reports. Therefore, all suggestions from users that can assist us in improving future issues will be welcomed.

The Central Statistical Office is grateful for the co-operation it has received from the Immigration Department, the Canefield and Melville Hall Airports, the Division of Tourism and the various cruise and airline agencies.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

### **THE FOLLOWING DEFINITIONS HAVE BEEN USED IN THIS REPORT**

**TOURISM:** Tourism denotes the temporary, short movements of people to destinations outside the places where they normally live and work, for other than business or vocational reasons and their activities during the stay at these destinations.

Tourism represents various types of short-term travel and visits and is variously defined for particular purposes, by reference to the purpose of the journey, its duration and other criteria.

**VISITORS:** A visitor is a non-resident person (national or alien) usually resident abroad, who enters Dominica and intends to stay for not more than one year for non-immigrant purposes such as touring, recreation, leisure, business, study or family reasons. Visitors have been divided into the following categories:

- (i) **TOURIST:** Any person who stays at least one night but not more than 365 nights in land accommodations.
- (ii) **EXCURSIONIST:** Any person who does not stay for any one night in any land accommodations.

Hence, an excursionist may either be a flight passenger who departs from Dominica on the same day he arrives, or a boat passenger who sleeps on board the vessel in a port of Dominica.

**RESIDENT:** Any person (national or alien) who has been residing or has been given permission to reside for more than one year and who has not yet been abroad for more than one year.

**TOURISTS ARE SUB-DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Holiday visitors whose purpose of visit is expressly stated as vacation. These visitors are classified either as staying in hotels, guesthouses or cottages, or as staying in private homes (i.e. with friends or relatives).
2. Business visitors who come for private as well as governmental business purposes. Included also are research workers from international institutions such the U.N., the I.M.F. and the CARICOM Secretariat.
3. Students who are permitted to enter to pursue a course of study at a school or university.
4. Other visitors, that is, visitors not covered by the previous three categories.

**THE COUNTRY GROUPINGS USED IN THE TABLES ARE DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:**

<b>O.E.C.S.:</b>	Antigua, Dominica, Grenada, Montserrat, St. Kitts/Nevis, St. Lucia and St. Vincent
<b>OTHER CARICOM:</b>	Barbados, Belize, Guyana, Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago
<b>FRENCH WEST INDIES:</b>	Martinique, Guadeloupe, The Saints, St. Martin and St. Bartholomew
<b>SCANDINAVIA:</b>	Norway, Sweden, Denmark with dependencies, Finland and Iceland

## 2005

### TRAVEL REVIEW

In 2005, visitors arriving into Dominica recorded to 79,907 with 99.2 percent stay-overs (79,257) and 0.8 percent excursionist.

However a 3.3 percent decrease was noted in visitor arrivals over the last year due primarily to a 7.9 percent drop in the Caribbean, the main market. A 5.1 percent increase was recorded from the United States, the second major market (Tables 1 and 1A).

Air arrivals increased by 4.2 percent in spite of the 3.3 percent drop in visitors arrivals, registering a 73.33 percent as the main mode of travel (Tables 2 and 3). The Caribbean Star airline continued its steady increase in market share accounting for 29.7 percent while Liat remains the main carrier with 34.4 percent. Visitors via chartered flights drop by 19.0 percent over 2004. The fall in chartered flights may have been triggered by the 27.25 percent decrease in Haitian arrivals. Express Des Iles continues to be the leading sea vessel with growth of 18.3 percent, transporting 96.8 percent of sea visitors to the island.

Tourist arrivals decreased by 1.0 percent over 2004 with only the Caribbean market recording a decrease, 4.5 percent. Percentage decreases were recorded in the French West Indies, 9.3; Other Caribbean, 3.4; and Other Caricom 2.6. On the other hand, Canada and the United States recorded market growth of 14.7 and 5.2 percent respectfully. For the European market, Holland recorded the highest percentage increase, 67.7 (Table 8B).

The average intended length of stay for stay-over visitors recorded 8.7 days with Europe and Canada registering 12.2, and 11.5 percent respectfully. The 4-7 days stay remained the most popular intended length of stay accounting for 48.5 percent of all stay-overs (Table 9 and 10). Holiday continued to be the primary purpose of visit registering 83.2 percent of tourist (Table 12A). However 64.7 percent of tourists stayed in private homes followed by 19.7 percent in hotels (Table 13A). The percentage of tourist at private homes have been increasing steadily since 2001.

Excursionist decreased sharply by 74.8 percent moving from 2,577 in 2004 to 650 in 2005. This fall was primarily due to a 79.1 percent drop in the French West Indies market with numbers moving

from 2223 in 2004 to 464 in 2005. The discontinuation of the services of Caribbean Ferries (sea vessel) in January 2005 significantly affected the market (Table 19A).

A 21.4 percent drop was registered in cruise ship passengers. Cruise arrivals moved from 383,614 in 2004 to 301,511. Although 2004 was a record year cruise arrivals in 2005 jumped 70.3 percent over 2003 and 23.3 percent over the last highest period, 1998 (Table 24).




VISITOR ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE: 2005


### VISITOR ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE 2001 - 2005



#### VISITOR ARRIVALS: 1996 - 2005





### PERCENTAGE OF TOURIST ARRIVALS BY PLACE OF STAY 2001 - 2005








### NUMBER OF EXCURSIONISTS: 1997 - 2005


### PASSENGER ARRIVALS BY CRUISESHIP 1997 - 2005
