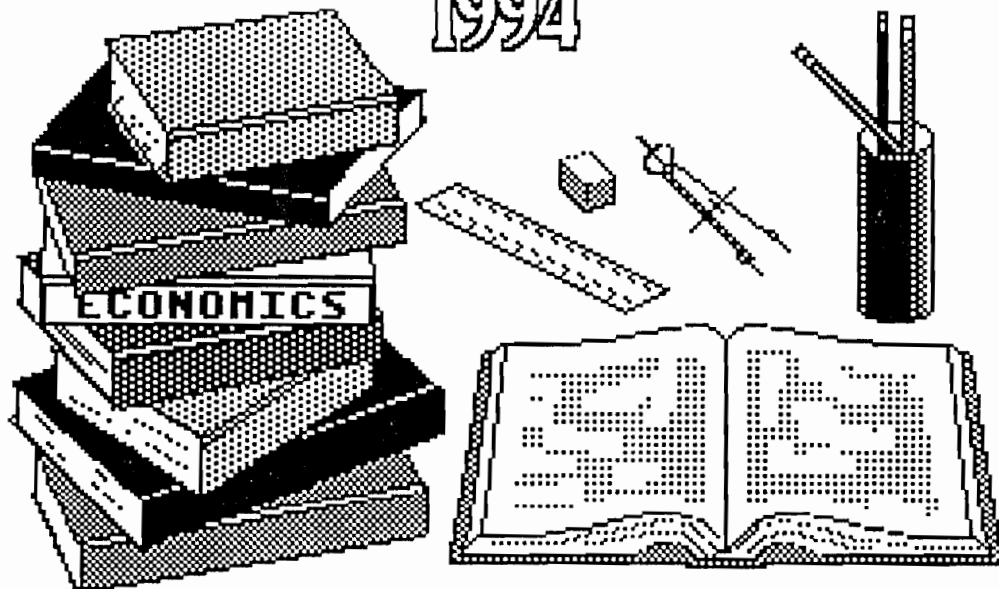
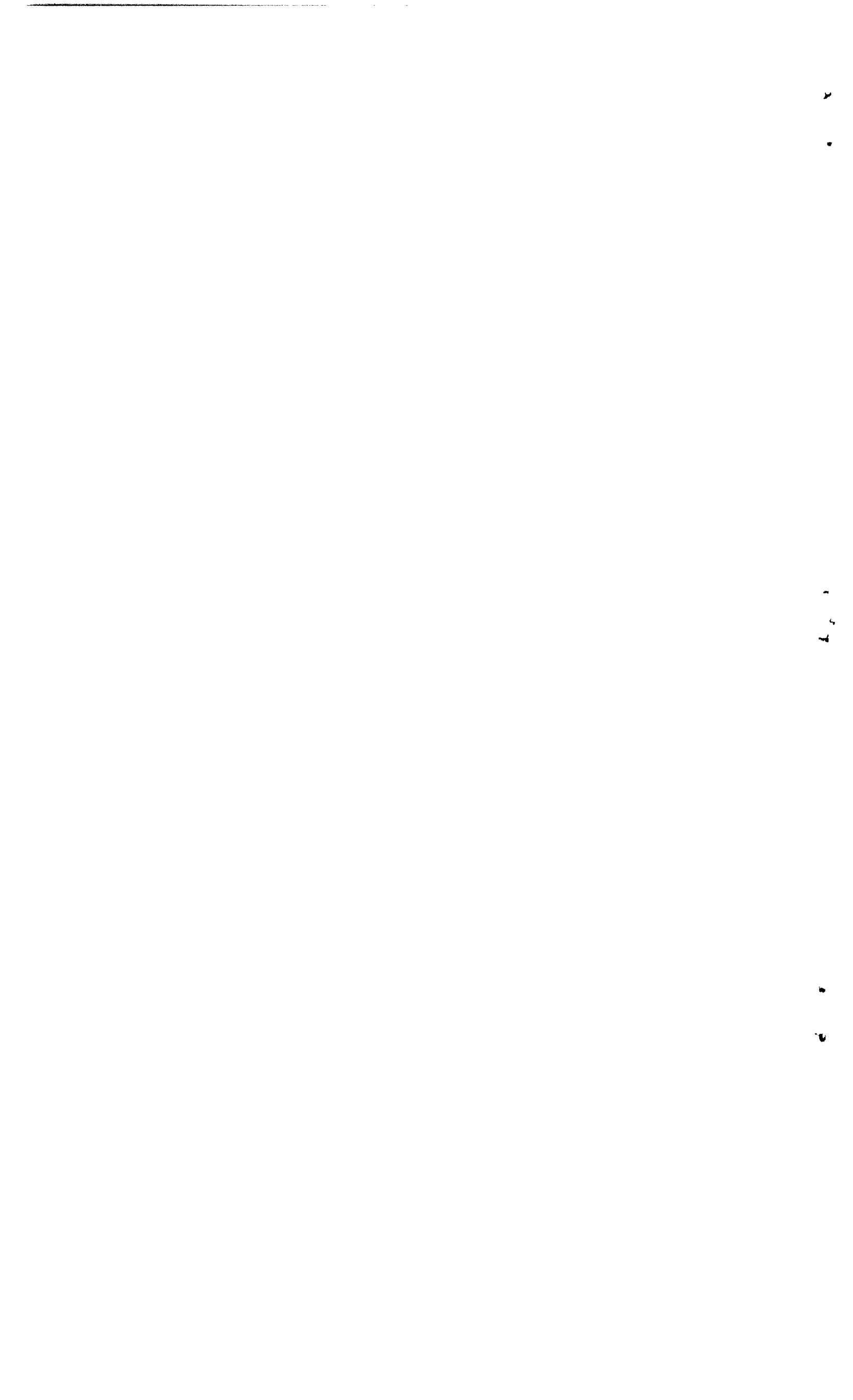


PREFACE

This detailed Education Statistics Report is the first published by the Central Statistical Office. Education Statistics had been previously presented in the annual Statistical Digest and Population Census Reports but not separately. This report covers a period of nine years under three sections: Enrollment, Examination Results and Expenditure on Education. It is intended to assist educators, government officials, planners and national, regional and international (donor) agencies to easily utilise education data on Dominica.

An end of year total population was estimated at 72,370 for 1992. Number of schools and general enrollment were classified according to parishes or population zones. For the 1992/1993 academic year Pre-Schools numbered 73, with an enrollment of 2,369; Elementary Schools numbered 65, with a student enrollment of 14,500. The Clifton Dupigny Community College had an enrollment of 426 students. There is a private off-shore medical school ran by a United States based institution. The University of the West Indies provides services to both part and full-time students in its continuing studies programme. Students are able to complete up to first-year university credits.

The office must acknowledge the efforts of Ms. Prayma Blaize in the preparation of this report. The Central Statistical Office is also grateful for the co-operation and assistance of Mrs. Virginia Thomas of the Ministry of Education. The general interest of Mr Charles Barnis, Co-ordinator of the Labour Market Information System (LMIS) and Mr. Daniel Shillingford, Co-ordinator of the Technical and Vocational Education Training (TVET) program, is also appreciated.

An analysis of this publication will follow shortly. All suggestions from users and readers which can help us in improving on the next issue will be welcomed.

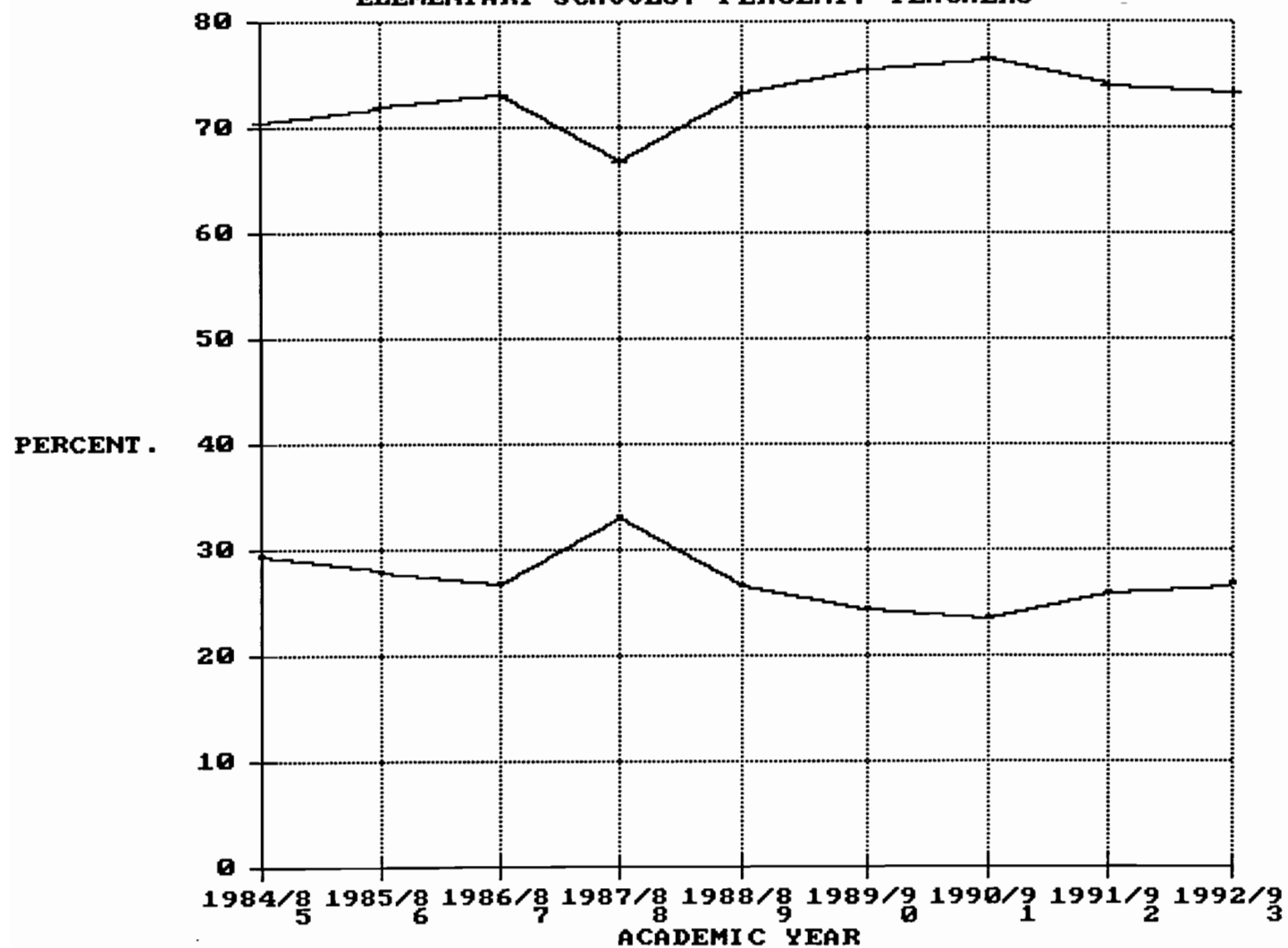

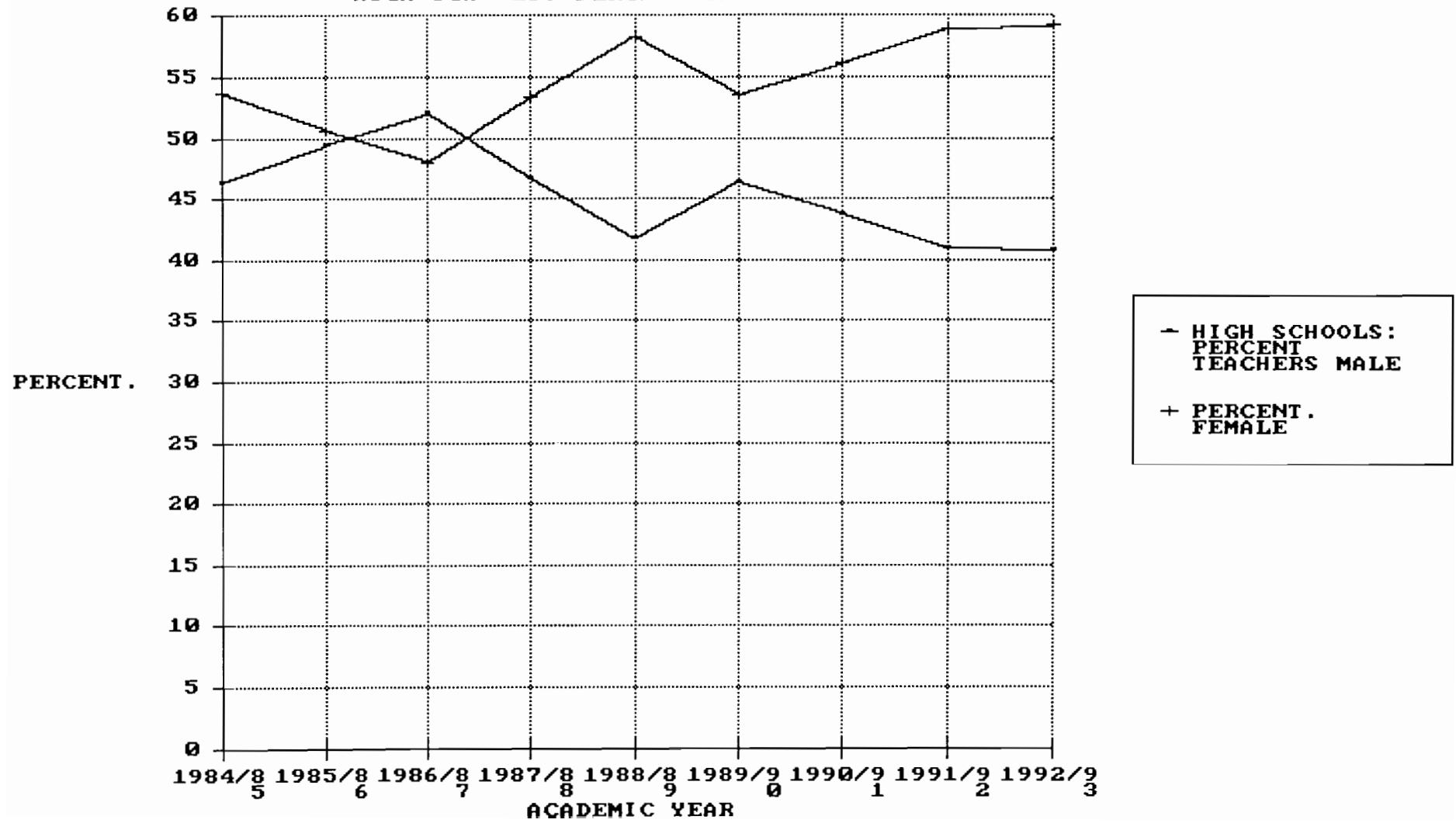

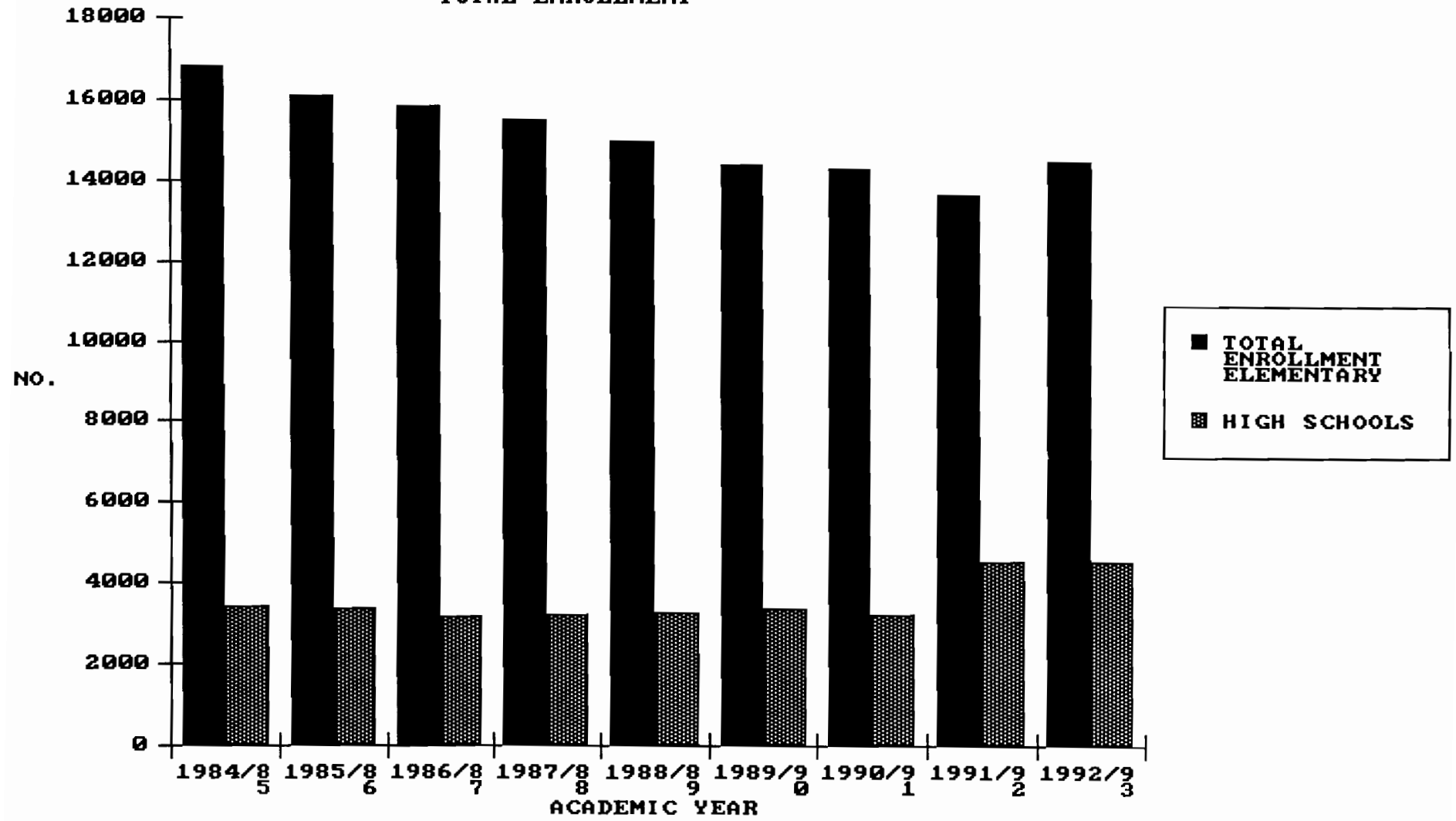

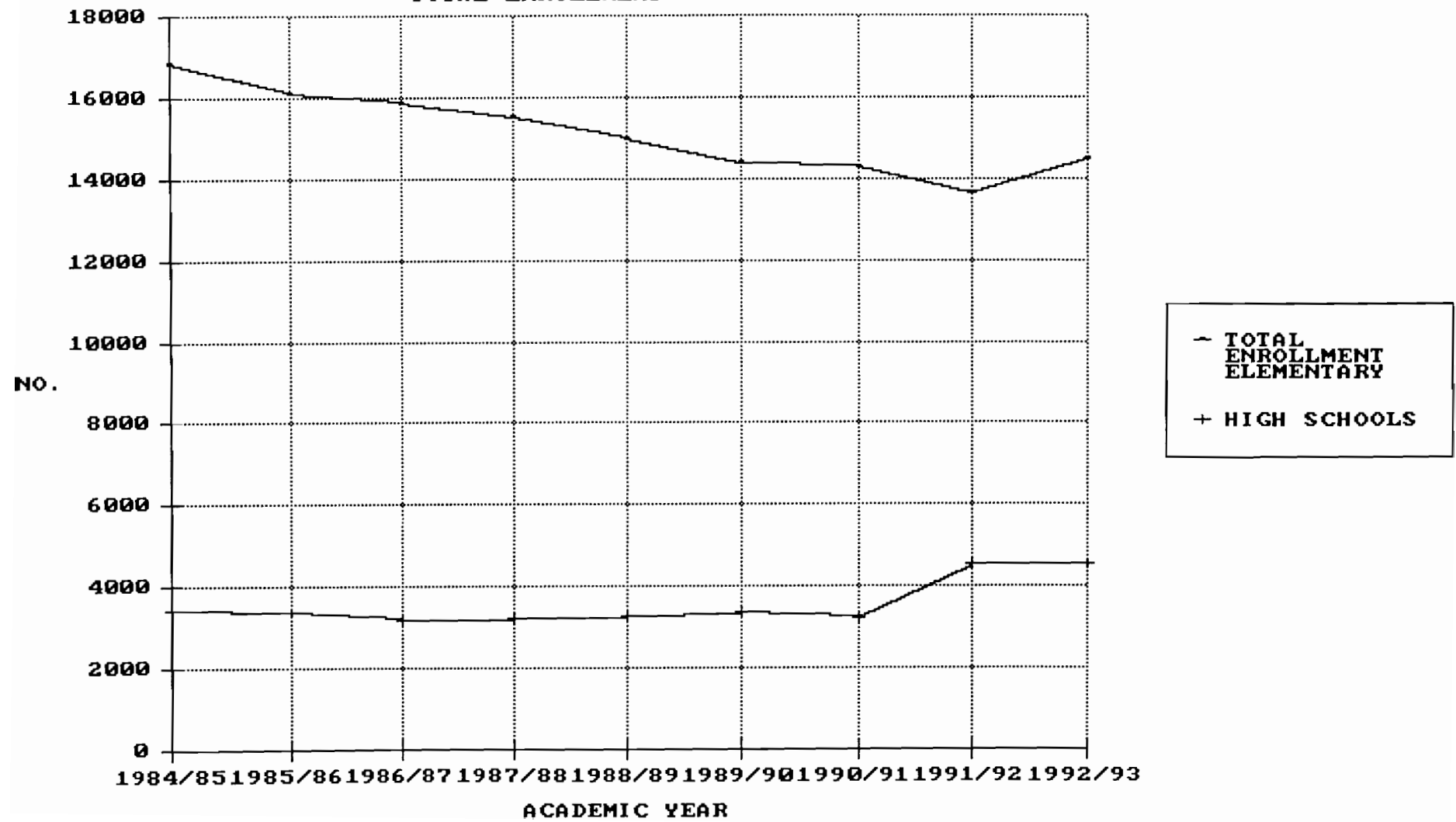
