


## PREFACE


This is the second issue of the national Education Statistics publication. The report covers data from the 1985/86 to 1995/96 academic years and presents three sections: enrollment, examination results and expenditure on education. At the end of the 1995/96 academic year there were 75 pre-schools(early childhood centers) with an enrollment of 2641 infants; primary schools numbered 64 with 14,320 students, 4,702 students were enrolled in 15 secondary schools and 598 students were attending college. A total of 22,261 were enrolled in educational institutions representing 29.8 percent of the mean population. The professional nursing, teacher and police training schools recorded a total enrollment of 150 students. There is a private off-shore medical school run by a United States based institution. The University of the West Indies also provides services to part and full-time students in its continuing studies programme. Students are able to complete up to first-year university credits.

The Central Statistical Office recognises the invaluable assistance of Mrs Virginia Thomas of the Ministry of Education. The office would also welcome any suggestions that can help us improve on future issues.

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
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## BRIEF REVIEW

A mean population was estimated at 74,729 for 1995. Schools and general enrollment were classified by parishes or population zones. Over the decade total school enrollment fell by 2.0 percent. Elementary school was the most affected, recording an 11.0 percent fall in enrollment. This decline was primarily due to steady migration of children in the 0 - 12 age group coupled with a declining birth rate. High schools however, registered an increase in enrollment as a result of a higher percentage of students selected from the common entrance(high school) examinations.

A higher percentage of females continually record a higher entrance success rate in comparison to males(Table 16). This trend has allowed a higher number of females in high school(Table 7). On the other hand, the repetition rate has been consistently higher(since the 1991/92 academic year) for males(Table 11).

The Caribbean Examinations Council was adopted as the main examining body for high school seniors from 1984. Prior to the Caribbean Council's examinations the University of Cambridge, England was the institution setting examination papers known as the General Certificate of Education(G.C.E). According to the 1995/96 Caribbean Examinations Council results, Mathematics, English and Chemistry recorded low national percentage passes relative to other academic courses- 31.4, 40.7 and 46.4 respectively. Food and Nutrition, Caribbean History, Integrated Science and Agricultural Science registered notable percentage passes of 98.4, 85.2, 83.3, and 77.7 percent respectively. The national percentage pass increased from 50.3 to 53.0 percent from 1992 to 1995. A higher percentage, 84.6, was recorded in 1984 as during that period Grades

111(General) and Grade 11(Basic) were included as passing grades. From 1992 only Grades 1 and 11(General) and 1(Basic) were considered acceptable passes.

Mathematics has been the most frequently pursued course by college students over the years.

However for the 1995/96 year, Sociology recorded the highest number of students. The five frequently pursued courses over the last four years were Mathematics, Sociology, Economics, Biology and Computer Science.

The elementary school programme has continually accounted for the highest percentage of education expenditure, recording 55.1 percent for the 1995/96 fiscal year. The pre-school programme registered steady decline in expenditure allocation since the 1993/94 year while greater emphasis has been placed on libraries and sports.

For the last ten years the number of students seeking funding for higher education from the Agricultural, Industrial and Development(AID) Bank student loan scheme reached a record low in 1995(Table 38).


