

PREFACE

This is the third issue of the national Education Statistics publication. The report covers data from 1996/97 to 2008/09 academic years and present three sections: Enrollment, Examination Results and Expenditure on Education.

At the end of the 2008/09 academic year, the number of pre-schools (early childhood centers) recorded 72 with an enrollment of 1,981 infant; elementary schools numbered 63 with 8,193 students; 6,930 students were enrolled in 15 secondary schools and for academic year 2006/07, 1,999 students were attending college.

A total of 19,496 were enrolled in recorded educational institutions representing 27.1 percent of the mean population. This excludes enrollment from two private off-shore medical schools, and continuing studies that are not registered with the Ministry of Education.

The University of the West Indies also provides services to part and full-time students in its continuing studies programme. Students are able to complete up to second year and higher university credits.

Other private post-secondary institutions provide services for continuing education at the high school, associate and degree level. Overseas universities also offer courses towards attaining associate, undergraduate and higher degrees.

Data analysis on National Assessment Programme for primary education implemented in 2002 for grade 2 and 2004 for grade 4 is presented in this report.

The Central Statistical Office recognizes the assistance of the Ministry of Education in the compilation of the data. The Office would also welcome any suggestions that can help improve on future issues.

REVIEW

Over the period 1997/98 to 2008/09, total recorded school enrollment registered steady decline throughout the period (Table 7.7). Enrollment in elementary school decreased steadily resulting in a significant 40.0 percent fall. High School enrollment recorded steady increases, up to the 2001/2002 period. From 2002/2003 steady decreases were recorded with a slight surge in 2005/2006. The net decrease in enrollment is mainly co-related to the sharp reduction in births. For the same period 1996/1997 to 2008/2009 births recorded a similar declining trend recording a sharp 22.0 percent decrease. Other demographic forces particularly migration also seem to have affected the school population.

From academic year 2004/05, the universal secondary education programme was implemented, thus achieving full selection of students for the secondary level.

Males (in secondary school) continue to register higher repetition rates throughout the reporting period (Table 11). Males also registered higher dropout rates with exceptions in academic years 2002/2003 and 2005/2006 where the dropout rates for females were slightly higher than that of males (Table 9).

The results of the Caribbean Examination Council reveals that, for the most recent academic year the seven highest percentage passes were recorded in Home Management and Electronic Documentation Preparation & Management (EDPM) 100.0; Food and Nutrition, 98.1; Office Procedures, 94.0; Integrated Science, 93.5; Clothing and Textile, 90.5; Social Studies, 90.3 and Principle of Business 89.3.

The national percentage pass improved in science subjects. Biology, Chemistry and Physics recorded increases in percentage pass over the last year. Biology moved from a percentage pass of 72.3 in 2006 to 83.7 in 2007 while Chemistry registered 77.1 in 2007 compared to a percentage pass of 55.9 in 2006. In 2006 Physics, recorded a percentage pass of 61.6 percent but moved to 65.0 percent in 2007. It is interesting to note that the national percentage pass was higher in French, 71.7 percent, than both levels of English, 58.1 and English B, 68.4 percent (Table 31).

Primary education accounted for the highest percentage of government actual expenditure on education, 35.6. This was followed closely by secondary education accounting for 34.9 percent. Public Library expenditure registered the lowest percentage, 1.8 percent of total expenditure (Table 35).

During the period 1996 to 2009, the highest number of students loans approved by the Dominica Agricultural, Industrial and Development Bank was 290 in 2003 (Table 37). In 2009, 17.9 percent of applicants were approved for study in Business Administration, which records the highest number of applicants for any course throughout the period. Studies in Accounting/Finance followed with 15.0 percent. Law and Nursing studies accounted for 7.1 percent each; Medicine and Education registered 5.7 percent each.

The Newtown Primary School was opened from the last reporting period. In the Parish of St. Andrew, the Bense SDA and the Wesley SDA merged to form the Temple SDA

From the last reporting period the Scotts Head Primary School, in the Parish of St. Mark was merged with the Soufriere Primary School.










