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## PREFACE

This is the fourth issue of the national Education Statistics publication. The report covers data from 2001/02 to 2011/12 academic years and presents three sections: Enrollment, Examination Results and Expenditure on Education.

At the end of the 2011/12 academic year, elementary schools numbered 60 with 8,144 students; 6,093 students were enrolled in 15 secondary schools and for academic year 2010/11, 2,004 students were attending college.

Enrollment data excludes enrollment from two private off-shore medical schools, and continuing studies institutions.

The University of the West Indies also provides services to part and full-time students in its continuing studies programme. Students are able to complete university degrees.

Other private post-secondary institutions provide services for continuing education at the high school, associate and degree level. Overseas universities also offer courses towards attaining associate, undergraduate and higher degrees.

Data analysis on National Assessment Programme for primary education implemented from 2002 for grade 2 and from 2004 for grade 4 is presented in this report.

The Central Statistical Office recognizes the assistance of the Ministry of Education in the compilation of the data. The Office would also welcome any suggestions that can help improve on future issues.

## REVIEW

Over the period 2001/02 to 2011/12, enrollment in elementary schools registered steady decreases throughout the period (Table 7.7) recording a sharp 25.9 percent over the decade. High School enrollment also recorded decreases, with minimal increases recorded in academic years 2004/05 and 2005/06. High School enrollment fell by 18.8 percent over the 2001/02 to 2011/12 period.

The net decrease in enrollment can be attributed to the reduction in births. For the same period, 2001/02 to 2011/12, births recorded a 20.2 percent decline. Other demographic forces particularly migration also seem to have affected the school population.

From academic year 2005/06, the universal secondary education programme was fully implemented, thus achieving full selection of students for the secondary level.

Males (in high school) continued to register higher repetition rates than females (Table 11). With the exception of both boys and girls recording similar dropout rates for academic years 2001/02 and 2003/04, the dropout rates for males were consistently higher than that of female students, particularly from the 2006/07 academic year (Table 9).

The results of the Caribbean Examination Council reveal for the most recent academic year (2012), the seven highest percentage general proficiency passes were recorded in Agricultural Science D/A, 100.0; Physical Education, 100.0; Agricultural Science S/A, 91.4; Principle of Business, 90.9; Music, 90.0; Physics, 87.6; Food & Nutrition, 87.0 and Social Studies, 81.1 (Table 33).

Agricultural Science D/A, and Physical Education were the only subjects recording 100.0 percent pass rate in the national percentage pass for the period 2012. Other subjects recording increases in percentage pass over the last year were; Electrical Technology, registering 65.9 in 2012 over 49.4 in 2011; Geography recorded 82.1 compared to a percentage pass of 76.8 in 2011; Physical Education, 100.0 over 96.6 in 2011; Physics recorded a 6.4 percentage increase over 2011, moving from 81.2 to 87.6; Principles of Business moved up from a percentage pass of 89.2 in 2011 to 90.9 in 2012. Social Studies also showed an increase in the percentage pass in 2012, registering 81.1 in 2012 over 78.5 in 2011. Electronic Documentation Preparation & Management (EDPM) recorded 71.1 in 2012 when compared to 67.9 in 2011. (Table 33).

English A recorded a decline in the national percentage pass in 2012 over that of 2011, decreasing from 79.8 in 2011 to 55.3 in 2012. English B also registered a decline from 81.0 in 2011 to 73.6 in 2012. Maths recorded its lowest percentage pass for the reporting period 2001 to 2012, recording an all time low of only 27.9 percent. Among the science subjects sat, only Physics recorded an increase in percentage pass over the 2011 and 2012 period, moving from 81.2 percent to 87.6 percent. Biology decreased from 79.3 percent in 2011 to 73.7 in 2012 and Chemistry also recorded a decline in the national percentage pass, moving from 72.3 in 2011 to 62.4 percent in 2012 (Table 33).

For the 2011/12 financial year, secondary education accounted for 36.6 percent of government actual expenditure on education, followed closely by primary education accounting for 35.4 percent. The lowest percentage expenditure was recorded for the public library registering a percentage of only 1.9 percent of total expenditure (Table 37).

Out of a total of 116 loans approved by the Dominica Agricultural, Industrial and Development bank in 2012, the highest number was awarded to study in the field of Accounting/Finance, accounting for 14.7 percent. Business Administration, which represented the highest percentage in 2011, registered a marked decline of 57 percent, in the number of loans approved in 2012, Nursing, however, recorded an increase from 6 in 2011 to 15 in 2012, registering a 150 percent rise in applicants(Table 39).











The evaluation process administered by the Education Planning Unit, Ministry of Education assesses reading ability, decoding and comprehension. Special needs students are evaluated using the MICO diagnostics test and other methods.
